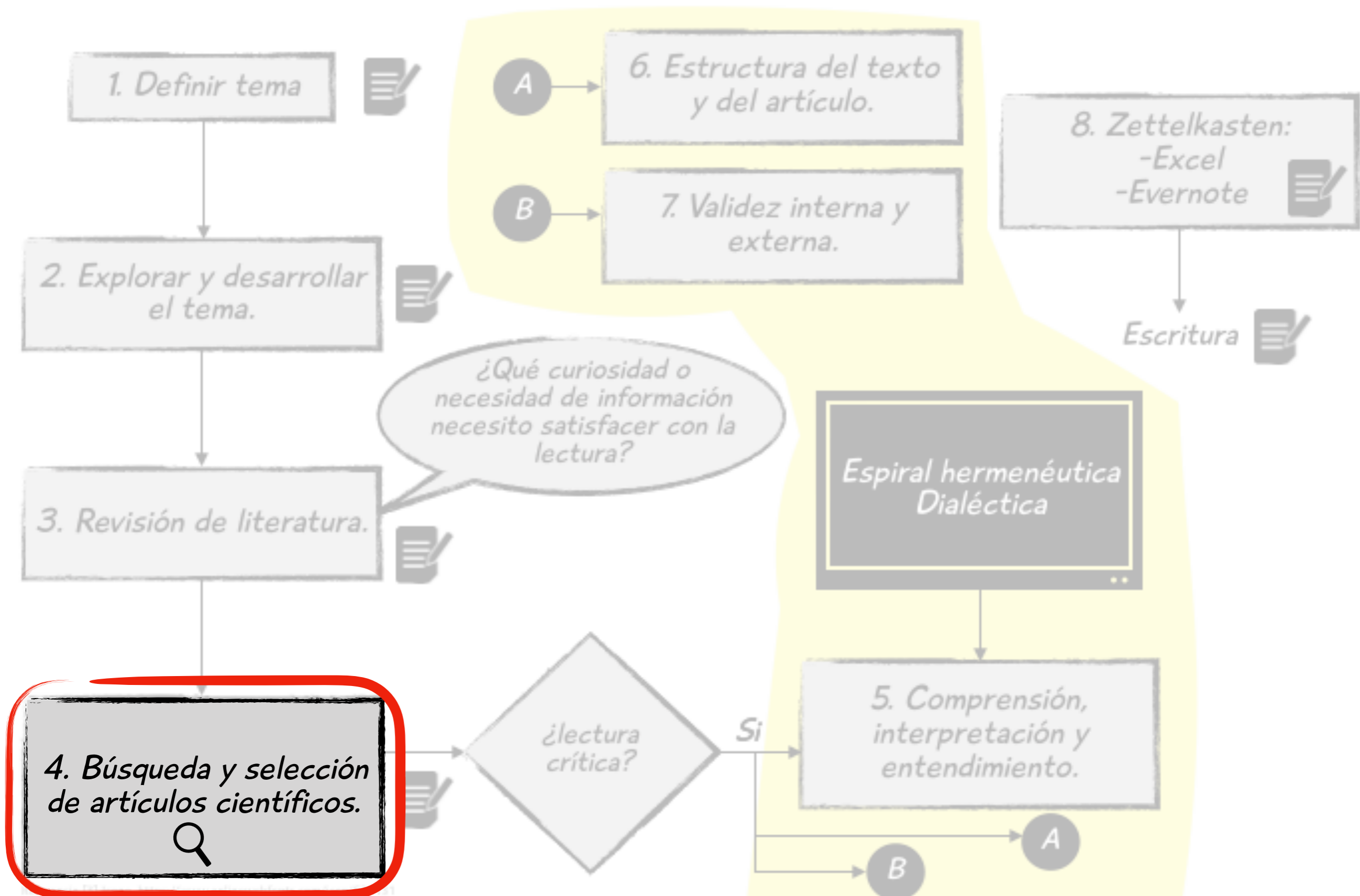

Traditional approaches to modeling semi-arid systems use hydrogeological models, water balance equations, and simplified water demand functions. 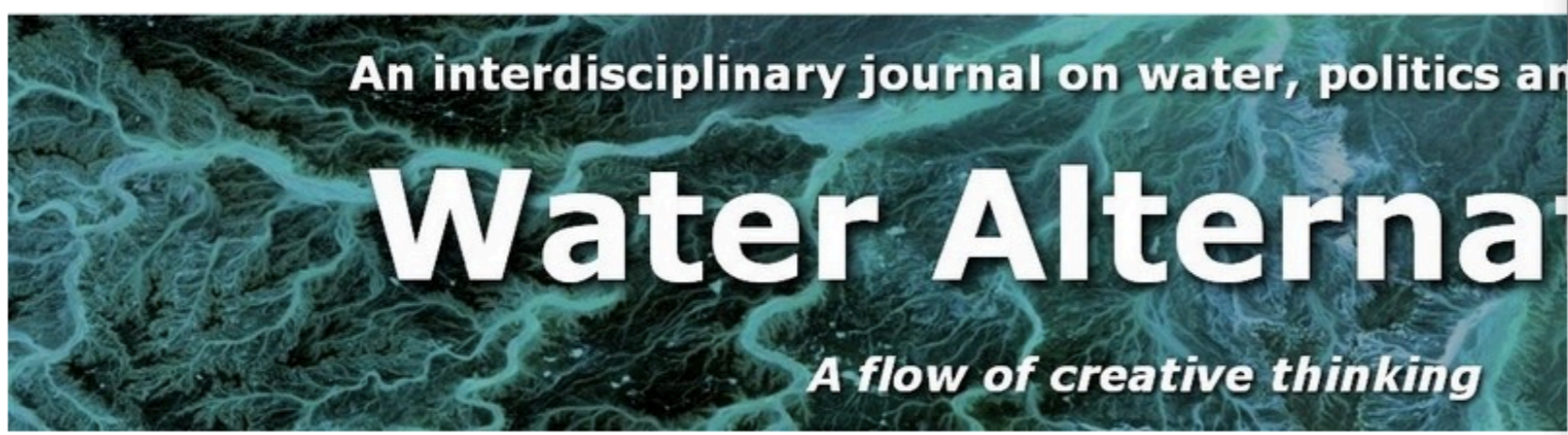

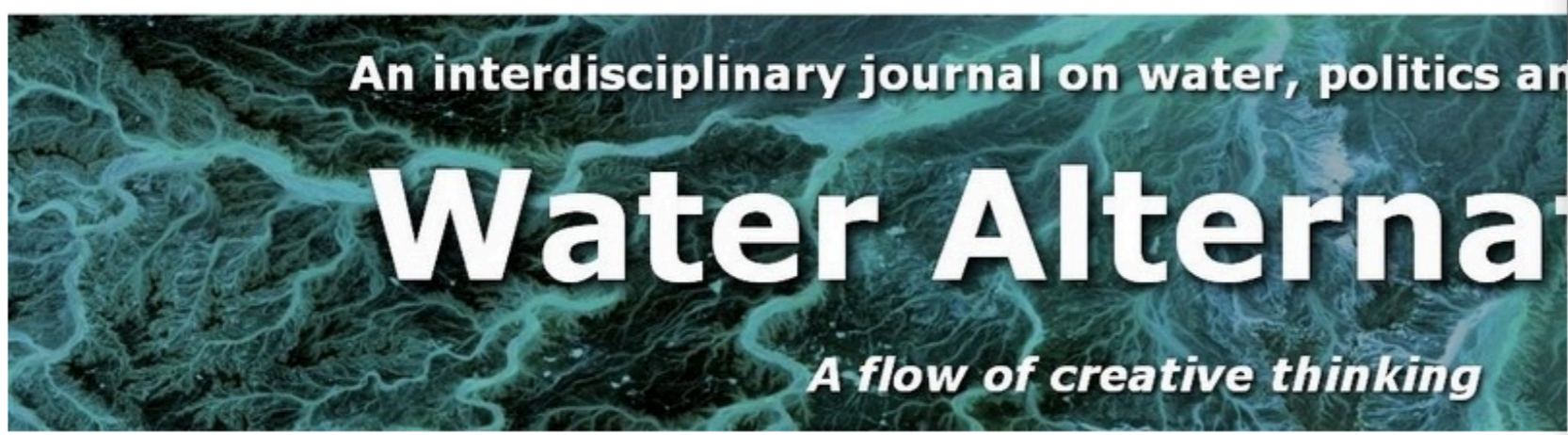
